Aquinas Institute is located one block from the campus of Saint Louis University. Our students have complete access to the academic, cultural and recreational opportunities of this Jesuit urban university.

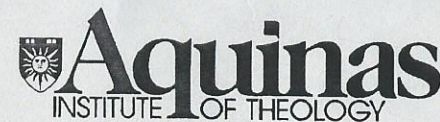
The Graduate Certificate in Spiritual Direction
