REMINDER – ELECTION SEASON

In the document *Faithful Citizenship*, the US Bishops Conference has outlined the important principles to be considered in voting. They include Protecting Human Life, Promoting Family Life, Pursuing Social Justice and Practicing Global Solidarity. Teaching, from the pulpit or otherwise, which omits comprehensive reference to all these principles does a disservice to the Bishops' efforts to fully inform the consciences of the Faithful and may be viewed as selective and partisan. Homilists are encouraged to be mindful that the goal of the Church to encourage Catholics to vote, while not endorsing specific candidates or political parties, cannot be achieved by fragmenting the message of *Faithful Citizenship*.

Also, please remember that distribution of political literature (propaganda, endorsements of political party or candidate, etc.) on parish property is prohibited. These publications are not proper for distribution on parish property as they engage in partisan politics. Please do not allow political literature to be distributed by parishioners or anyone else in the Church or on parish property unless it is voter education material prepared by the USCCB or has the specific approval of the Archbishop's office.

SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF MARY

The solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of Mary (December 8) falls on Saturday this year. The obligation to attend Mass on this day is maintained. The precept is maintained because Our Lady under this title is the patroness of the United States, as well as this Archdiocese. 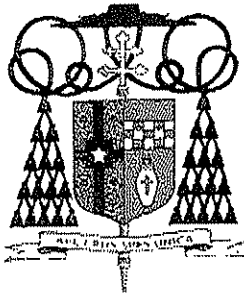

83RD SESSION OF TEXAS LEGISLATURE – ADVOCACY ARCHANGELS

January 8, 2013, will mark the beginning of the 83rd Session of the Texas Legislature. The Texas Bishops have worked in collaboration with the staff of the Texas Catholic Conference to formulate the Bishops' 2013 legislative priorities for the upcoming session. While the priorities are extensive and encompass a broad range of issues, there are three key areas in which the TCC will focus significant resources: payday lending, advance directives and school choice.

The TCC has requested that each diocese identify Advocacy "Archangels" at the parish level to assist in coordinating a grass roots response throughout the legislative session to engage our parishioners in continuing their roles as faithful citizens. In early November, the Pastors of the Archdiocese will receive correspondence from Cardinal DiNardo requesting the identification of one to two individuals to serve as Advocacy Archangels for their local parishes. Please look for this communication from Cardinal DiNardo and respond quickly in identifying individuals to fulfill this important role. There will be an initial orientation and training session in Houston for the Archangels on December 4, 2012, led by Jeff Patterson and Jennifer Allmon of the TCC. To: All Pastors

My brother priest:

In his Prayer for Generosity, St. Ignatius of Loyola asks for guidance in living selflessly. "Teach me to serve you as you deserve; to give and not to count the cost ...to labor and not to ask for reward, save that of knowing that I do your will."

This prayer comes to mind as I reflect on the faithful service of our nation's elder religious. These women and men – Catholic sisters, brothers and religious order priests – never stopped to count the cost as they educated the young, cared for the sick and sought justice for the oppressed. In so doing, they made an inestimable contribution to the Church in the United States, establishing Catholic schools, hospitals and social-service agencies

Today, many senior religious continue to manifest God's love and generosity by serving in a wide range of volunteer activities. Others, though sometimes frail and infirm, remain dedicated to a ministry of prayer. Nearly all are challenged by the rising cost of care. Most elder religious worked for years for small stipends, leaving a substantial gap in retirement savings. A majority of religious communities now struggle to provide necessary medications, nursing care and basis services for their older members.

The annual Retirement Fund for Religious will be taken up on the weekend of December 8-9, 2012. This is an opportunity for each of us to emulate the generosity exemplified by our senior religious. I encourage you to invite a religious or lay volunteer to speak about the appeal and to utilize the materials available online at www.retiredreligious.org. Most importantly, please be sure to announce the collection during Mass.

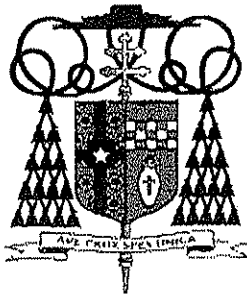

To the Faithful of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston:

Pope Benedict XVI has inaugurated a Year of Faith. It is a beautiful occasion for us to dedicate ourselves to the deepening of faith and to increasing the knowledge of our faith. It is an occasion to renew our call to holiness. Our Holy Father has also announced the Church's offering of the gift of indulgences as an opportunity to open ourselves to the purity of heart and the penitential spirit associated with this year of grace.

During the Year of Faith, which continues until November 24, 2013, plenary indulgence for the temporal punishment of sins may be gained for the benefit of oneself or for the souls of the faithful departed. The gaining of indulgences requires certain prescribed conditions, most notably that the person: 1) possesses an interior disposition of detachment from sin, 2) celebrates the Sacrament of Reconciliation, 3) receives the Holy Eucharist, 4) prays for the intentions of the Holy Father, and 5) recites the Profession of Faith. For a more comprehensive explanation of the Church's teaching on the practice of indulgences and their necessary prescriptions, please refer to the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* Nos. 1471–1484 and the USCCB website. It is worth noting that the conditions for an indulgence require a proper spiritual disposition and not a mechanical observance of prescribed actions.

An individual forms a proper interior disposition for attaining the indulgence by spending a period of time in prayer and meditation. This time in prayer may be done in one of the designated places of pilgrimages in the Archdiocese. During the Year of Faith, the following churches are designated as pilgrimage sites:

- Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart (1111 St. Joseph Parkway, Houston)
- Shrine of the True Cross (300 FM 517 E, Dickinson)
- St. Patrick Catholic Church (Holy Family Parish, 34th and Ave. K, Galveston)
- Annunciation Catholic Church (1618 Texas Ave., Houston)
- Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church (2405 Navigation Blvd., Houston)
- Prince of Peace Catholic Church (19222 Tomball Parkway, Houston)
- Guardian Angels Catholic Church (5610 Demel St., Wallis)

On any day during the Year of Faith, the faithful may attain an indulgence. In addition, I am designating the following days as a special occasion for receiving the graces of an indulgence: December 8 (Immaculate Conception), Our Lady of Guadalupe (December 12), February 22 (Chair of St. Peter), March 19 (St. Joseph), June 7 (Solemnity of the Sacred Heart), September 14 (Exaltation of the Cross), and October 11 (Anniversary of the Inauguration of the Second Vatican Council).

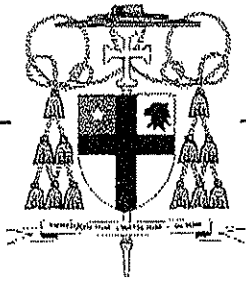
