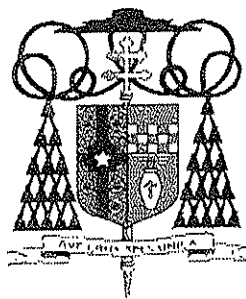

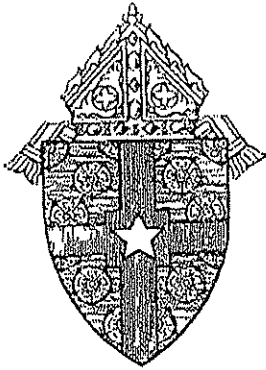

Minutes
Meeting of June 18, 2013

The Council convened in the conference room of the Bishop Nold Building at St. Mary Seminary. Fr. Rivers Patout presided and called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Fr. Miguel Solorzano offered the opening prayer. Fr. Bart Reynolds took the roll.

MINUTES: The minutes of April 16, 2013, were read and approved with one correction: Fr. Dan Lahart, S.J. was in attendance at the last meeting.

The scheduled report on the status of the permanent diaconate was postponed.

Bishop Sheltz gave an update on the renovations at the Seminary. The Borski Gymnasium is being updated, to provide more classrooms and meeting rooms, as well as improved exercise rooms. Construction should be completed before the end of the year. The cost of the first phase will be about five million dollars.

Subsequent phases may include updating dormitories and other seminary facilities.

UPDATE ON CATHOLIC CHARITIES: Cynthia Colbert, the President and CEO of Catholic Charities, made a presentation on their work in the Archdiocese. Prior to coming to Houston, Mrs. Colbert was Executive Director of Austin Catholic Charities, followed by three years of service at Catholic Charities of Wichita, Kansas.

The Mission of Catholic Charities has three emphases: 1) nurturing and caring for children; 2) strengthening marriages and families; 3) promoting independence, especially for the elderly, those living with chronic conditions, and refugees.

The Council noted the increasing need for counseling services. A paramount concern in expanding services is maintaining a strong Catholic identity of programs. There was a discussion about the major issues faced by parishes and a consideration of the role that Catholic Charities could play in resolving them.

It was suggested that Catholic Charities could work more with the Social Justice Office of the Archdiocese to create a better understanding of Catholic social teaching.

REPORT FROM DAVID HESSEL: Bishop Sheltz introduced the new Director of HR for the archdiocese, Charlie Pavlovsky.

Representatives from Gallagher Benefits Services, who gave a presentation on preparing for the financial consequences of healthcare reform. They are working to assure that the archdiocesan insurance plans meet or exceed the minimum value requirements of the new law.

David Hessel presented the budget for the upcoming fiscal year. It is in balance, with no projected deficit. There is a great deal of uncertainty surrounding healthcare cost estimates.

The Council recommended that the budget be approved as proposed.

NEXT MEETING: The next meeting of the Presbyteral Council will be held at St. Mary Seminary on Tuesday, July 30, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. in the Conference Room of the Bishop Nold Building.
