As we prepare for the 39th annual National Diaconate Institute for Continuing Education (NDICE) session, I'm extending my welcome to you to join deacons and their wives from across the U.S. to the longest continuous education conference for diaconate ministry. *Deacon: Teacher of the Faith, by Word and Deed* is the 2013 theme, and we meet at Xavier University, Cincinnati, Ohio, on July 21-24.

Mass is an important part of every NDICE session, and on Sunday afternoon, Auxiliary Bishop Joseph Binzer of Cincinnati will be the celebrant of the opening Mass. After dinner, the keynote address will be given by Daniel Mulhall from Boston. Mulhall is the former Assistant Secretary for Catechesis and Inculturation for the USCCB, and his address will fit in well with the conference theme of "deacon as teacher of the faith."

The two Monday morning sessions will be given by Daniel Mulhall. In the afternoon, Deacon Thomas Winninger, a nationally-known speaker and author, will be the presenter for the first two afternoon sessions. Sr. Maureen Sullivan, who is a religion consultant for the RCL Benziger publishing company, will be the presenter for the final Monday afternoon session. She is the author of two books related to Vatican Council II.

On Tuesday morning, Dr. Sean Reynolds, a nationally-known expert in youth ministry training and certification, will be the presenter at the two sessions. With more than 30 years of experience, he has served on the USCCB Commission on Certification and Accreditation. The Tuesday afternoon sessions will be given by Dr. Patricia Hughes, Director of Worship for the diocese of Dallas, Texas; she has been involved with church ministry for over 45 years. Sr. Maureen Sullivan will address the wives session, which focuses attention on the important role wives have in their husband's diaconate ministry. In the evening, the hilarious "Deacon Follies" gives everyone the chance to exhibit their acting and singing "skills." This is always a "hit" at NDICE, and while no one has gone on to Hollywood or Nashville fame, you will enjoy this relaxing evening!

Bishop William Skylstad, returning for his eighth consecutive year, will be the presenter at the Wednesday morning session. A great supporter of the diaconate, he will be the celebrant of the closing Mass, at which he will install NDICE officers for the coming year.

So all is set for another great NDICE! This is truly a "national" education session; we have presenters this year from Ohio, Texas, Washington, Minnesota, Kentucky and Massachusetts, and will again have deacons from 30 states or more. 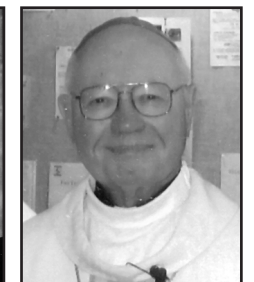
