

Where do I start?

School is starting soon and that means all those other activities for children are gearing up. Scouting, team sports, gymnastics, and dance classes are just a few of the programs that are available for children and young people. Regardless of how much or how little extracurricular activity is part of a child's life, one thing is certain—safety first must be the motto of parents, guardians, and other caring adults when choosing program activities for children and young people.



Knowing that, what is the best way for caring adults to make sure that programs are doing all they can do to make sure that children and young people have a safe and enjoyable experience?

In Step 3 of Protecting God's Children® for Adults, we recommend that adults and organizations "Monitor All Programs." For the most part, the emphasis in this step has been on overseeing programs on the premises of the church or school. However, as we begin to consider activities for the children in our lives, there is an opportunity to apply the principles of the program in the investigation and evaluation of programs and activities for our children.

As a caring adult, monitoring all programs should include three significant inquiries before you leave your child to participate.

Protecting God's Children™ Re-certification Training Module for Adults

Welcome to the *Protecting God's Children*™ re-certification training module for adults. This interactive training module is designed to refresh your memory about key points from the *Protecting God's Children* awareness session you attended approximately one year ago.

This module is constructed around multiple-choice questions that apply the 15 knowledge points from the *Protecting God's Children* awareness program. For each knowledge point, you will first answer a multiple-choice question. After you select an answer, you will be prompted to read an overview of the relevant issues addressed in the question. Then, you'll see the same question, again, and be prompted to either accept your original answer, or to change your answer based on the information provided.

Each wrong answer will provide additional background information designed to help you select the correct answer. Upon completing all 15 lessons, you will be re-certified through the *Protecting God's Children* program and will continue to receive the affiliated privileges as determined by your diocese—e.g., be eligible to continue your ministry—working and interacting with minors as a part of your role in the faith community.
